

**Part III****Central conclusion**

Central conclusion:

Based on performed self-assessment of compliance with conditions for service unbundling and accounting separation set by the Code of Conduct, CDCP declares that it fulfils requirements of the Code of Conduct with the difference in direct allocation of costs to services. Mentioned discrepancy is caused by historical development and valid organisational chart and CDCP currently does not dispose of organisational and technological equipment that would allow CDCP to remove such discrepancy. In case of the entire replacement of financial information system and in case of future need for identification of partial direct allocation of costs to a specific type of service, CDCP will make an effort in solving this discrepancy.

CDCP fully meets requirements of the Code of Conduct concerning unbundling of provided services and accounting separation.
